Elizabeth II's Death

The Queen died on Thursday, September 8th 2022 at Balmoral Castle in Scotland

Queen Elizabeth II was born on April 21, 1926 in London. She died on Thursday, September 8, 2022 at the age of 96 due to the death of her father. She died at Balmoral Castle in Scotland. The funeral was held on September 19 at 11 a.m. She had 4 children, they are called Princes Charles, Edward, Andrew and Princess Anne. Her husband was Prince Philip. She was crowned on June 2, 1953 at Westminster Abbey, London, United Kingdom. Her mother was Elizabeth Bowes-Lyon (Elizabeth Angela Marguerite), born 4 August 1900 in London and died 30 March 2002 in Windsor Castle in Scotland.



Elizabeth II has a sister Margaret born in August 1930 and who died in 2002 at the age of 71 from multiple strokes.

In 1960, Margaret finally married a commoner, Antony Armstrong-Jones. They had two children, David born in 1961 and Sarah born in 1964. In 1978, the two spouses divorced.



The Prince of Wales becomes Charles III

After, the funerals of the Queen Elizabeth II, Charles III would become King at 73 years old. He was born on 14th of November 1948, at Buckingham palace. He married Diana Spencer in 1981. He had two children William and Henry. The King Charles III will be crowned on May 6th 2023.

What will be replaced
