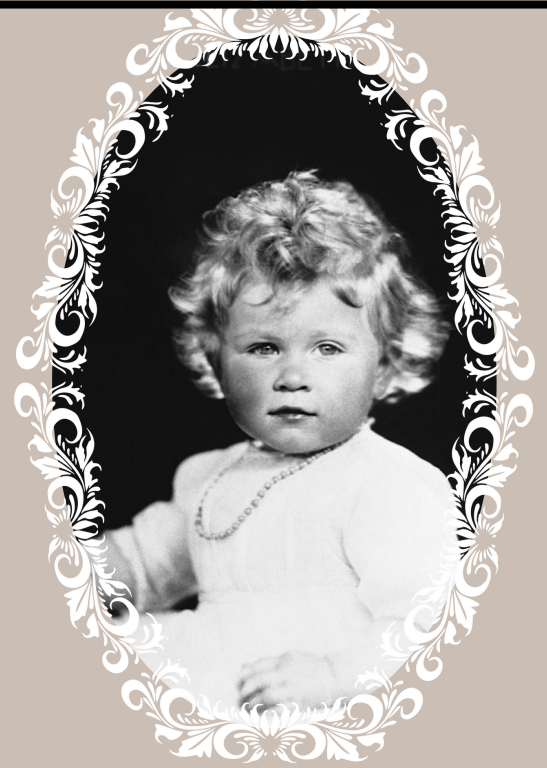
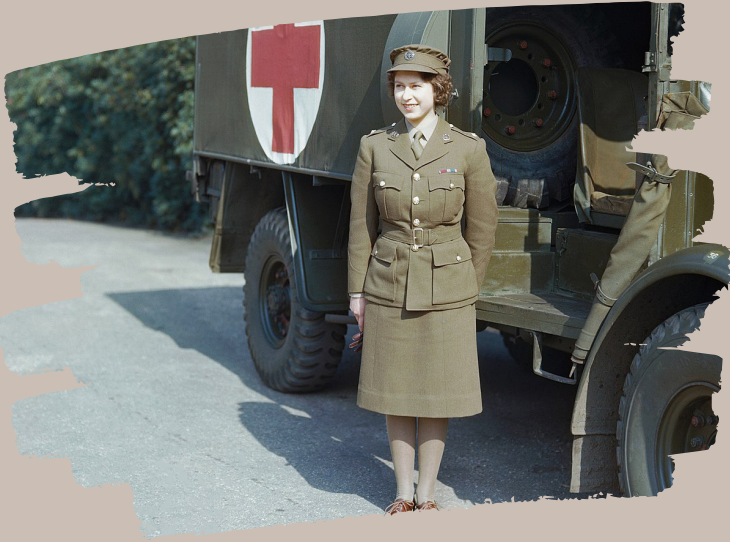


The Extraordinary Royal Life of Elizabeth II

On 10 December 1936, Edward VIII announced his abdication. The King of England ceded his throne so that he could marry the woman he loved, the American Wallis Simpson, who was twice divorced. He became Duke of Windsor and was succeeded by his younger brother, the Duke of York, Elizabeth's father, as George VI.
